Subject: Re: {OHG} Jon . . . fertilizing with molasses?

Liquid molasses - 1-3 Tablespoons to the gallon.

Granular molasses (from feed stores) - 10lb per 1000 sq ft.

Remember - molasses is sugar - apply \*very\* infrequently and sparingly lest you suffer rot problems due to sugar induced bacterial bloom. Once annually on the lawn and garden. Perhaps the same in potted plants too. I predigest my molasses in my humus tea fermenter to avoid bacterial bloom - I mix in vermicompost and aerate it for 24 hours. That way I can use it more to reap more benefits like the trace minerals present and am able to boost microbial levels in the soil and on plant surfaces pretty safely.
