

CHIAPPA FIREARMS 1911-22

MADE OF:

Frame, slide and some internal parts are made of CHIAPPALLOY®, a special zinc-based alloy with copper and aluminium, with high-performance mechanical characteristics and in particular an excellent resistance to wear.

Barrel (bottom rifled), firing pin and ejector are made of tempered steel.

Magazine is made of polymer.

FINISH:

Being made of Chiappalloy, all metal parts are blued. They can therefore be touched up with the special products generally used to repair barrels where the blueing is damaged.

Standard version: blued finish

Tactical version: black matt satin finish

Target version: black matt satin finish with polished sides of the slide

By all versions the grips are made of wood and are interchangeable with the originals.

SAFETIES:

1. Slide safety on the left side
2. Hammer safety on the right side, near the rear sight (with a special key supplied in the box)
3. Trigger safety when the slide movement is not carried out properly
4. Half-cock position

VERSIONS

Standard: Rear sight adjustable in windage only, fixed front sight

Target: Rear sight adjustable in windage and elevation, dovetail front sight

Tactical: Rear sight adjustable in windage only, dovetail front sight

Tan: tan colour slide, sights as per standard version.

Green: green colour slide, sights as per standard version.

PACKAGING:

Each gun is packed in an elegant and convenient ABS carrying case, which includes one 10-rounds magazine, a clearing brush, the instructions and safety manual, the safety key.
