Here are the 9 badass survival solar devices we love and you should too:

#1 - SOLAR FIRE STARTER



A solar fire starter is basically a magnifying glass that is specifically design to start fires.

The good news is its pocket sized and never runs out of fuel.

While this one won't really help out with the energy bill, it's pretty badass and takes you one step closer to absolute self-reliance. No need for butane, no need for a spark, just need some decent sun.

#2 - SOLAR POWERED MASON JAR



This is a spin-off of your basic garden variety solar light. It's a solar cells that feed a battery that lights a LED bulb.

Nice for those off grid nights (or when SHTF) when a bit of indoor light could be very handy.

Hang these outside for some free outdoor lighting or bring them inside. They are perfect for an off grid cabin where a little evening light would be helpful.

#3 - SOLAR POWERED FLASHLIGHT



Having a solar powered flashlight is an excellent way to extend the life of your survival gear.

Normal flashlights will eat up batteries and then be useless. Not so with a solar powered flashlight.

I recommend having one of these in your Bug Out Bag. Some of these some with battery backup so if you hit a cloudy period or forgot to charge it during the day, it'll still be useful to you.

#4 - SOLAR POWERED REFRIGERATOR



Not a cheap device but still very cool (pun intended!). Just imagine having the ability to keep your food cool when the power goes out.

Plus your refrigerator is one of the highest electrical usage devices in your entire home.

The storage capacity is significantly less than a standard sized refrigerator but it works without grid power...

#5 - SOLAR POWERED GENERATOR



This is perfect for your all-purpose power needs. Just leave the panel out in the sun and then use the generator as needed.

Free power from the sun to be used for just about any small electrical device...nice.

This one is definitely one you can deploy immediately and often. The sun's power is free and this device will allow you to harness its power whenever you need it.



Put this device on your roof and get some hot water via the sun.

The best way to apply this device today is as an alternative to your traditional hot water system. If its summer / sunny out you can use this device and save some money. If not you still have the convenience of a traditional system.

#7 - SOLAR POWERED SUN OVEN



If you know what you're doing when it comes to fires and dutch ovens then you can survive without this but it can still be a very nice to have device.

Plus you can save some \$'s on energy today and start practicing your off grid cooking skills now.

#8 - SOLAR HANDCRANK RADIO



At a minimum you should have a basic radio in order to tune into emergency communications. It may be one of the only ways to get information during a longer term survival scenario.

In order to ensure you can “stay in the loop” get a solar one.

As an added bonus get one with a hand crank to charge your smaller electronic gadgets.

#9 - SOLAR CAMPING SHOWER



Without power, you probably won't have indoor water and even if you do, it won't warm. It will be a cold shower.

With this device, you'll be able to get a warm shower anytime you can keep it out in the sun for a day.
